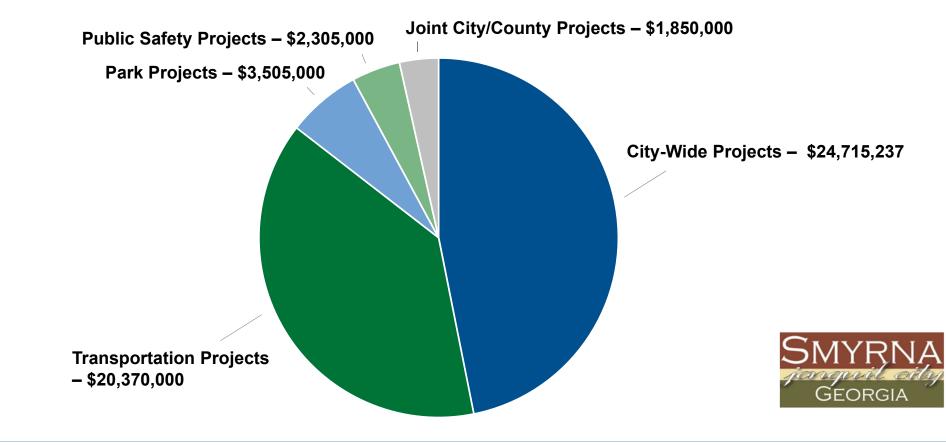

SOUTH COBB DRIVE IMPROVEMENTS

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FAMILY LEARNING LIBRARY

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A public library transformed into a community center for literacy, early childhood development, parent education, family support, and community information.

Programming Services –

- Storytime and interactive materials
- Workshops on parenting and family literacy
- Classes incorporating play and sensory experiences

Facility Features –

- Multi-purpose programming room, main reading room, and nursing room
- Maker Lab and separate interactive play space
- Interior/Exterior book drop with sorting mechanism
- Public computers and free WiFi
- 12,000 square feet
- \$385,000 estimated budget
- 2 full-time, 1 part-time staff

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This project will replace the various APX mobile, portable, desktop, and weather siren radios currently in use by the Police Department, SWAT, and Fire Department for an estimated cost of \$1,962,964.00.
